Catchment boundaries are defined by the equal distance between state schools, and are measured by the shortest, most direct trafficable route (by road) to and from the main entrance at the school (return journey). However, in some cases, negotiated catchment catchments for specific schools are in place to account for unique local road or access conditions.

Catchments are not fixed or static and are reviewed annually by the Queensland Government Statistician Office (QGSO) to make adjustments for any new housing developments and/or changes to road networks that have occurred during the preceding 12 months.

The release of catchment updates are generally made available to the public by the end of Term 3 to ensure maps are available for the commencement of the peak enrolment period. These maps can be viewed on the EdMap website at http://www.ggso.gld.gov.au/maps/edmap/.
