
Renewing Our Schools: Upgrading school infrastructure

Program overview

The Queensland Government is investing **\$235 million** in the Renewing Our Schools program to upgrade school infrastructure across the state.

For many of the schools, this will be the most significant infrastructure investment in decades. The program will deliver both new and refurbished modern learning facilities for all schools during 2021.

Up until this point the program has been in the planning phase and this year, will begin moving into the delivery phase.

The Department of Education has partnered with the Department of Housing and Public Works, Building and Asset Services (BAS) team to deliver the program.

The Department has completed site visits to consult with each school and scope infrastructure renewal requirements. This signature program is delivering a broad range of exciting projects to meet school needs including multipurpose sports centres, resource centres, general learning areas, science laboratories, performing arts centres, the refurbishment of existing facilities, IT hubs and communication upgrades – all informed by local school priorities.
