


Background:

School-based hubs approaches

There has been growing evidence of the efficacy of school-based hub approaches in driving improved education, health and life outcomes for students, families and communities, especially in areas of low socio-economic status and accompanying high levels of developmental vulnerability amongst children.

At a broad level, evaluation of school-based hubs, interstate and internationally, have identified a range of common outcomes including:

- Higher class attendance, which leads to improved numeracy and literacy scores.
 - Improvement in the communication skills of preschool children.
 - A greater degree of parent engagement in school activities.
 - It's more convenient for parents to access multiple services in one place.
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Background:

School-based hubs approaches – Australian programs

A range of school-based hub programs have been established across Australia and internationally.

Australian programs

- **FamilyLinQ – Queensland’s first integrated school-based hubs** (a partnership between The Bryan Foundation and Queensland Government)
 - **Yarrabilba Family and Community Place – a co-located hub in Queensland**
 - Our Place – Victoria
 - Schools as Community Centres – New South Wales
 - School as Community Hubs – South Australia
 - Community Hubs Australia – Australia
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What is FamilyLinQ?

FamilyLinQ is Queensland's first integrated school-based hub – designed to connect government and social services across education, health and community to improve life outcomes for children and their families.

FamilyLinQ integrated school based-hubs will also enable parents to engage in skills and training opportunities on a school site.

FamilyLinQ will be located at two sites - at an existing primary school and a new primary school.

Improved connection and engagement of students and families in the FamilyLinQ school community



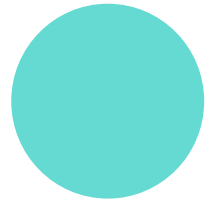
