### Discrete Communities Infrastructure program

#### **Improving schools for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.**

The Discrete Communities Infrastructure (DCI) program is a Queensland Government program which provides funding to better plan, improve and build educational buildings and spaces by co-designing them with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

#### **The Doomadgee DCI co-design program**

For the past 12 months, the Doomadgee Aboriginal Shire Council members and key school community members have been working with the DCI team to co-design a master plan and identify key projects for Doomadgee State School.


Next steps:

### SHORT-TERM PROPOSED PLANS

- 1 Completed cultural hub (previously manual arts)
- 2 New yarning circle
- 3 New car park and drop-off zone
- 4 New play area for Prep-Year 2
- 4A New covered play area for Prep-Year 2
- 5 New covered walkway
- 6 Amenities refurbishment to include accessible use
- 7 Sports oval upgrade

### MEDIUM-TERM PROPOSED PLANS

- 8 Administration refurbishment and extension
- 9 New lift for accessible use
- 10 Extend covered court area
- 11 New junior covered playground
- 12 New multi-purpose court
- To be demolished:
  - Block A lower level
  - Old playground

### LONG-TERM PROPOSED PLANS

- 13 New senior covered area
- 14 Welding shed refurbished into training workshop
- 15 New senior speciality building
