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Have your say on new facilities for Goodna Special School

Planning new facilities to support teaching and learning

The Queensland Government is planning a long-term solution to cater for future student numbers in the Goodna area. The number of students at Goodna Special School has grown fast, going up by more than 80% since 2020.

In Term 1 this year, two new temporary, two-storey prefabricated classroom buildings and other facilities were delivered, ready for teaching and learning.

The Queensland Government is now seeking feedback on Stage 2's proposed facilities. The proposed developments will provide the school with new and/or upgraded facilities to meet curriculum and extra-curricular needs.

The Goodna Special School concept site plan is included overleaf and shows the proposed location of Stage 2.

Stage 1 in progress, ready for Term 1, 2026

Works include:

- removal of two existing single-storey temporary buildings (6 classrooms) and an amenities building
- replace with a temporary two-storey prefabricated building (12 classrooms and amenities).

Stage 2 (unfunded)

The proposed developments will include:

- new play space including a partially covered playground with access ramp and lift
- car park for staff and school community
- amenities.

Please note: The delivery of Stage 2 is subject to the availability of funding in the future.

Next steps

Construction of Stage 1 has commenced and works are expected to take three months, weather dependent.
