#### Improving schools for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

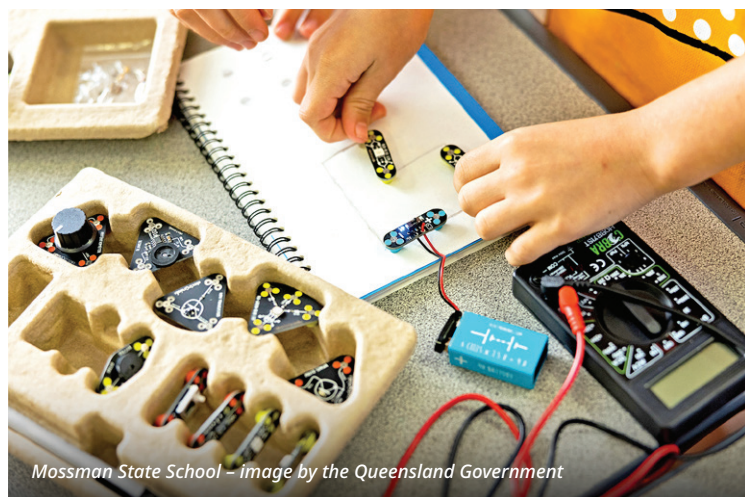
The Discrete Communities Infrastructure (DCI) program is a Queensland Government program which provides funding to better plan, improve and build educational buildings and spaces by co-designing them with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

#### The Mossman DCI co-design program

For the past 12 months, key community members and school representatives have been working with the DCI team to co-design a master plan and identify key projects for Mossman State School.

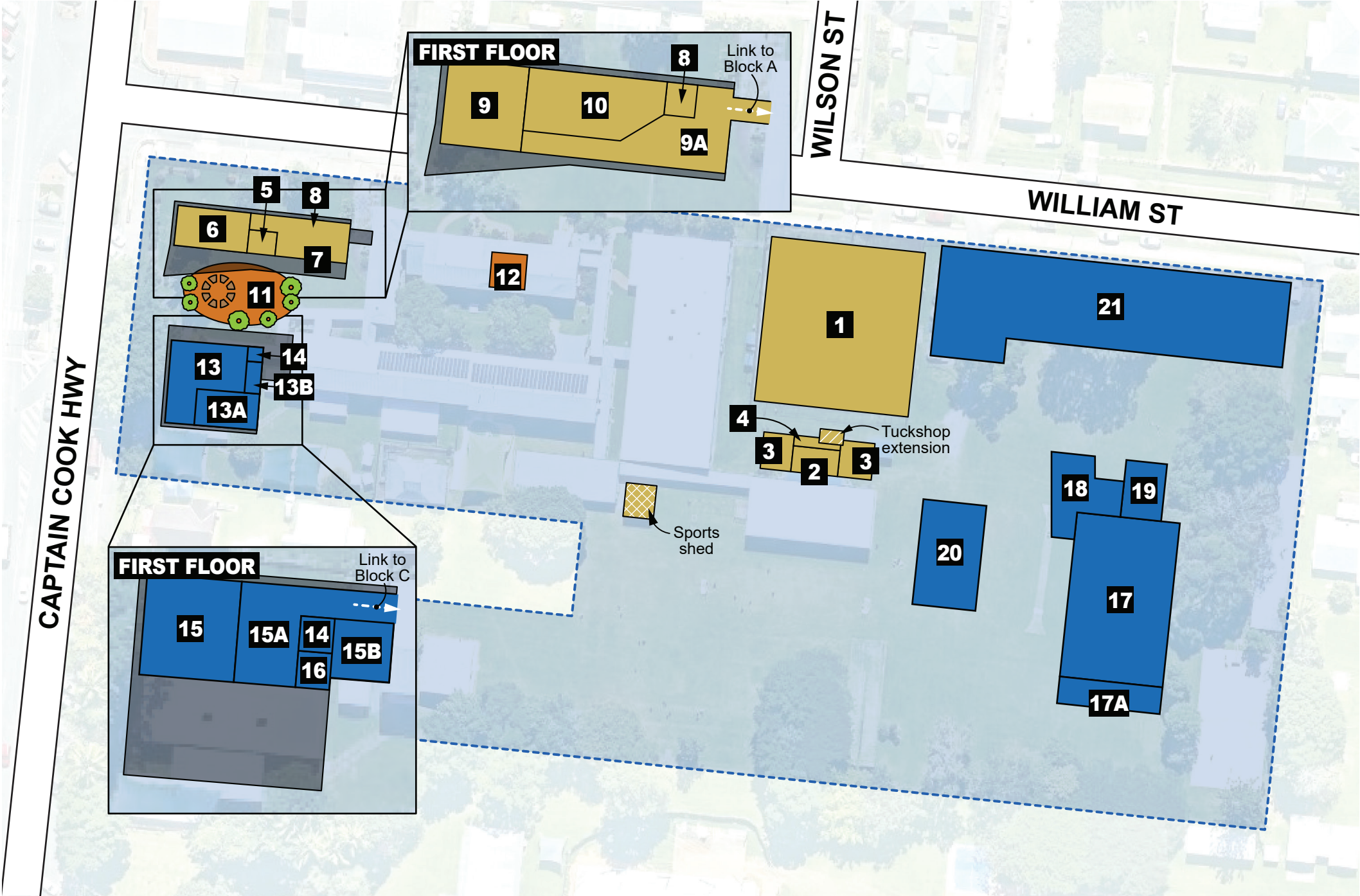
Next steps:

# Mossman State School master plan

**STAGE 1 POTENTIAL PROJECTS**

- 1 Covered sports courts
- 2 Tuckshop and walk in cold rooms to be refurbished
- 3 New changing rooms
- 4 Sports shed new area
- 5 New toilets for after hours use
- 6 New cultural space
- 7 New administration, meeting room and foyer
- 8 New lift to provide access to Block A and Block B
- 9 New teaching spaces including a 9A FlexiSpace or break out area
- 10 New FlexiSpace, toilets, cleaning and store room
- To be demolished:
  - Existing tuckshop extension

**STAGE 2 POTENTIAL PROJECTS**

- 11 After hours precinct with bushtucker area and yarning circle
- 12 Old administration to be repurposed into staff room spaces

**STAGE 3 POTENTIAL PROJECTS**

- 13 New Block P playgroup area including an 13A undercover learning space and 13B toilets
- 14 New lift to provide access to Block C and Block D
- 15 New specialty learning areas including 15A outdoor teaching spaces and 15B toilets
- 16 New storage unit for Prep
- 17 New multi-purpose hall with 17A stage
- 18 New foyer and store room
- 19 New toilets for hall
- 20 New OSHC building central to car park, tuckshop and hall which includes toilets and store room
- 21 Car park extension

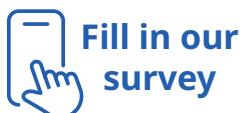
