

## ADDRESSING THE NEED

### Brisbane's new inner west primary school

The Department of Education is planning a new primary school to relieve student enrolment pressures at Indooroopilly and Ironside state schools. The new school will provide long term enrolment capacity in the local schooling network. This will ensure all families who wish to send their children to local state schools are able to do so.

#### 6,034 POPULATION INCREASE

There is a forecast population increase of 6,034 in the suburbs of Indooroopilly, St. Lucia and Taringa between 2016-2041.



#### MANAGING ENROLMENT GROWTH

Enrolment growth over the past five years has been driven by in-catchment students with more than 650 additional in-catchment students attending Indooroopilly and Ironside state schools while out of catchment enrolments have declined by more than 30%.



#### ACCOMMODATING FUTURE GROWTH

A new school will provide the additional long-term capacity needed to meet growing enrolment demand. Indooroopilly and Ironside state schools have limited room to expand beyond the short-term.



#### NEW LEARNING SPACES

With the delivery of the new primary school for Brisbane's inner west, new learning spaces will be provided to service the local community.
